

CLOSE TO THE ACTION

Montgomery County is located on the northern border of Washington, DC and on the border of Virginia. Baltimore is northeast, and Annapolis is directly east of the county. Communities with quick and close access to Washington, DC include Bethesda, Chevy Chase, Potomac, Silver Spring, Rockville, and more.

GETTING AROUND

BY METRO & BUS

There are 13 Red Line Metro stations that serve Montgomery County. These stations also offer transfers to Metro and Ride On buses.

Metro Buses and Montgomery County's Ride On buses serve most neighborhoods in the county.

BY BICYCLE

Capital Bikeshare system offers bicycles for rent at more than 300 stations in Maryland, Washington, DC, and Virginia.

Staying at the Canopy by Hilton at Pike & Rose? The hotel offers a bike loaner program for guests.

BY CAB, CAR SERVICE OR RIDE SHARE

Barwood Taxi has served Montgomery County since 1960, and features Verifone technology with credit card payment and video onboard.

BY TRAIN

Amtrak, the intercity rail, services BWI Airport and Union Station in Washington, DC. Take Ride On Bus 201 from BWI or MetroRail's Red Line from Union Station.

BY CAR

From points northwest: I-70 East to I-270 South

From points northeast: I-95 South to I-495 towards Virginia and then I-270 North, or I-95 South to MD 200 West (MD 200 is an all-electronic toll road that only accepts the E-Z Pass for payment. If you do not have an E-Z Pass, you will receive a bill in the mail at a slightly higher rate.)

From points south: I-95 North to I-495 towards Baltimore and then I-270 North

BY FERRY

White's Ferry is the last of the 100 historic ferries that used to operate on the Potomac River. It offers a shorter and faster route for drivers from Leesburg, Virginia to Montgomery County. Call 301-349-5200 for weather related closures.



Metrorail System Map




YOUR WEEKEND *Your Way*







IT'S TIME TO RELAX & RECHARGE

Rockville Civic Center Park is centrally located and surrounded by some of Rockville's best places — Glenview Mansion, Croydon Creek Nature Center, F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre, formal gardens and a forest preserve.

The Croydon Creek Nature Center is a short distance from downtown Rockville. HISTORY + HERITAGE

Founded in 1776, Montgomery County has done an incredible job in preserving and sharing the history of the community. History buffs will delight seeing the past come to life at these publicly accessible historical attractions in the area.



The Chesapeake & Ohio Canal (C&O)

For nearly 100 years, The Chesapeake & Ohio Canal (C&O) was a lifeline for communities along the Potomac River. Today, it endures as a pathway for discovering historical and recreational treasures!

Take a trip back in time aboard the mule-drawn Charles F. Mercer packet boat at the Great Falls Tavern Visitor Center or stay overnight in a lockhouse through the award-winning Canal Quarters program managed by the C&O Canal Trust.

Don't forget to visit The Monocacy Aqueduct. As the largest of the 11 aqueducts erected along the C&O Canal, it is often described by many historians as one of the finest canal features in the United States.



Woodlawn Manor Cultural Park

Experience Maryland as it looked in the early 1800s by visiting Woodlawn Manor Cultural Park in Sandy Spring. The Woodlawn Visitor Center is a stone barn full of interactive exhibits that tell the story of a bustling farm and the earliest residents of the Woodlawn community. Walk the Underground Railroad Experience Trail and imagine what it was like to be a freedom seeker.



The National Museum of Health and Medicine

Home of the bullet that killed Abraham Lincoln, The National Museum of Health and Medicine in Silver Spring offers a treasure trove of collections dating back to the Civil War.

Clara Barton National Historic Site

The Clara Barton National Historic Site, which includes the Clara Barton House, was established in 1974 to interpret the life of Clara Barton (1821–1912), an American pioneer and founder of the American Red Cross. Guided interpretive tours are available every hour on Fridays and Saturdays.

National Capital Trolley Museum

The National Trolley Museum was established in 1959 to preserve and interpret the history of area electric streetcars. The renovated Visitor Center features exhibits on streetcar history, a display of historic trolleys, and a model of streetcars and street life in Chevy Chase in the 1930s. Ride vintage streetcars on a 2-mile track through Northwest Branch Park.

Beall-Dawson House

The Beall-Dawson House was built in 1815 by Upton Beall, and then owned by the Dawson family and eventually the Davis family. Today, the house is the headquarters for the Montgomery County Historical Society. It still contains most of its original architecture, including the indoor slave quarters, and serves as a museum of life in 19th Century Rockville.



White's Ferry

A unique cable ferry in operation since 1786. A popular crossing point for troops during the Civil War, it was known as Conrad's Ferry until being renamed after Confederate Col. Elijah Veirs White. The automobile ferry crosses the Potomac River between Poolesville and Leesburg, Virginia every 20 minutes.



DARBY HISTORICAL CULTURAL PARK

The Darby Store in Beallsville is considered one of the few existing examples of a rural, vernacular general store dating from the early 20th Century in Montgomery County. After an extensive rehabilitation by Montgomery Parks, the storefront is now a thriving general store selling a mix of home goods and locally-sourced products.

Explore
HIKING TRAILS

Sugarloaf Mountain in Dickerson, MD is open to the public for hiking, rock climbing, and sightseeing. Sugarloaf offers three well-marked hiking trails: a 2.5-mile, 5-mile or a 7-mile loop. A popular trail is the Blue Northern Peak Trail loop. The Blue Trail Loop is a 5.5-mile loop trail that offers scenic views and is rated as difficult. The trail is primarily used for hiking, rock climbing, and walking and is accessible year-round.

Billy Goat Trail

A 4.7-mile hiking trail that follows the path between the C&O Canal and the Potomac River within the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal National Historical Park near Great Falls in Montgomery County. The entire Billy Goat Trail is made up of three separate sections, which start and finish on the C&O Canal.

Brookside Gardens

For an afternoon of light hiking, explore the 50-acre award-winning public display garden at Brookside Gardens within Wheaton Regional Park. Featuring two conservatories, the park is open year-round with events such as the Wings of Fancy and Garden of Lights.

RENT A KAYAK

Experience Little Seneca Creek Park, the beautiful 505-acre lake as well as the wildlife that make the lake their home. The park, comprised of 6,300 acres, extends along 14 scenic miles of Seneca Creek, as it winds its way to the Potomac River. This area contains many scenic areas, including the 90-acre Clopper Lake, surrounded by forests and fields. Kayak rentals are available May through September.

Visitors to Rock Creek Regional Park can enjoy the beautiful 75-acre Lake Needwood in rental kayaks, rowboats, canoes, or pedal boats. Guests can also take a tour of the lake aboard the Needwood Queen during the summer season.



ROPES COURSES

Go Ape in Rock Creek Regional Park in Rockville is home to six zip lines, numerous rope ladders, 44 crossings to include the Stirrups and Twister, two Tarzan swings, and America's first skateboard zip line.

The Adventure Park in Sandy Spring consists of 13 different courses varying in degree of difficulty. Each trail has zip lines, but primarily consists of bridges between tree platforms made of rope, cable, and wood configurations, creating over 190 unique challenges.



ENJOY A BIKE RIDE

The C&O Canal is a US National Historical Park home to 184.5 miles of towpath that runs parallel along the northern banks of the Potomac River with numerous trails ideal for biking and hiking. The park is also popular for running, biking, fishing, boating, and kayaking.

On the southern banks of the Potomac River is the Capital Crescent Trail. It is an 11-mile biker-hiker trail running from west Silver Spring to Georgetown, DC. The trail was formerly used as the Georgetown Branch rail line of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

The Music Center and Mansion at Strathmore
High-quality arts programming, served with the hospitality and warmth of a family enterprise, are the hallmarks of The Music Center and Mansion at Strathmore. The 1,976-seat theater regularly hosts favorites like the National Philharmonic Orchestra and the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra. The Mansion at Strathmore hosts smaller performances and private collections. Walk the elaborate Sculpture Gardens, enjoy tea in the Strathmore Tea Room, or catch a music festival on the front lawn.

AMP by Strathmore
AMP is your place to come together for great music at Pike & Rose, an urban-minded, Metro-accessible neighborhood in North Bethesda. Powered by Strathmore, AMP puts a premium on authentic live music and comedy experiences, bringing new energy to this growing neighborhood.



The American Film Institute (AFI) Silver Theatre and Cultural Center
The American Film Institute (AFI) Silver Theatre and Cultural Center in Silver Spring is anchored in the restored 1938 Silver Theatre, creating a classic feel to the films and movies shown within its walls. AFI examines the significance of films, while showing filmmaker interviews, discussions, and other events, making the films a true centerpiece.



The Fillmore Silver Spring
The Fillmore Silver Spring brings a dynamic, first-class music, and entertainment venue to downtown Silver Spring. With a capacity of 2,000, The Fillmore features an array of diverse live music programming.

Olney Theatre Center
Olney Theatre Center offers a diverse array of professional productions year-round that enrich, nurture and challenge a broad range of artists, audiences and students. One of two state theaters of Maryland, the center is situated on 14 acres in the heart of the beautiful Washington-Baltimore-Frederick "triangle," within easy access of all three cities.

BlackRock Center for the Arts
Located in Germantown, the BlackRock Center for the Arts presents performances featuring top regional, national, and international touring talent from the worlds of pop, jazz, roots, rock, blues, folk, world, and classical music, as well as dance and theater for young audiences and families.



Round House Theatre
Round House Theatre is a home for outstanding ensemble acting and lifelong learning. Known for its adventurous programming and deep investment in local talent, Round House has become a premiere destination for the serious theater enthusiast in the Washington, DC region.

Arts Barn
Recalling the charm of a bygone era, the Arts Barn is a beautifully renovated stable that once housed horses on the former Tschiffely Estate. Today, the Arts Barn is part of Arts on the Green, the city of Gaithersburg's home for visual and performing arts, including a 99-seat theatre.

Imagination Stage
Located in Bethesda, Imagination Stage offers year-round professional theatre shows, classes and camps for toddlers, children and young adults.

Arts & Entertainment DISTRICTS

Maryland is one of the first states in the country to develop Arts and Entertainment Districts on a statewide basis. These districts help develop and promote community involvement, tourism, and business revitalization through tax-related incentives that attract artists, arts organizations, and other creative enterprises.

Montgomery County is home to three Arts and Entertainment Districts — Wheaton, Silver Spring, and Bethesda. Each district offers a wide range of arts and humanities organizations, popular arts venues, festivals, entertainment businesses and more.



There are 26 A&E Districts in Maryland. Three are in Montgomery County!

MONTGOMERY COUNTY'S *Rural Side*

▶ One third of the county is preserved for agricultural use.

▶ There are 540 farms and 350 horticultural enterprises.

▶ Montgomery County has the most acres planted in berries (blackberries, blueberries and strawberries) of any county in Maryland.



▶ Agriculture contributes over \$287 million to the county's economy.

Montgomery County, Maryland is home to a surprising number of rural areas. In 1980, the Montgomery County Council made one of the most significant land-use decisions in county history by creating an Agricultural Reserve, or what the locals call the "Ag Reserve." Heralded as one of the best examples of land conservation policies in the country, the Agricultural Reserve encompasses 93,000 acres, almost a third of the county's land resources.

Visit farms in the Agricultural Reserve in the spring for pick-your-own strawberries, blueberries, tart cherries, blackberries, red raspberries, and tomatoes. In the fall, families head out to the pumpkin patch, and during the holidays, they cut fresh trees. From the summit of Sugarloaf Mountain, hikers can look out over the county's pastoral patchwork of farms and villages, a countryside view largely unchanged since the 19th century.



▶ The county is home to the second-highest number of horses in Maryland (approximately 7,900).




McKee-Beshers Wildlife Management Area

Top of visitors "must see" lists is the sunflower fields at McKee-Beshers Wildlife Management Area in Poolesville. Sunflowers are planted by hand each year to attract game birds. Deer, wild turkey and more than 200 species of birds have been known to wander the park, which is alongside the Potomac River. Peak blooms typically occur in July.

Agricultural History Farm Park

The scenic 455-acre Agricultural History Farm Park in Derwood, MD features rolling hills, open fields, an apple orchard, and a variety of farm animals. Get a unique perspective on the county's rich farming heritage while visiting barns, historic buildings, a modern farming activity center, and other facilities at the park.



King Barn Dairy MOOseum

The King Barn Dairy MOOseum is a dairy heritage museum dedicated to interpreting the rich history of the farms, the families, and related organizations and businesses of Montgomery County. Their stories are told through a permanent collection featuring interactive exhibits and educational programs.


VisArts
