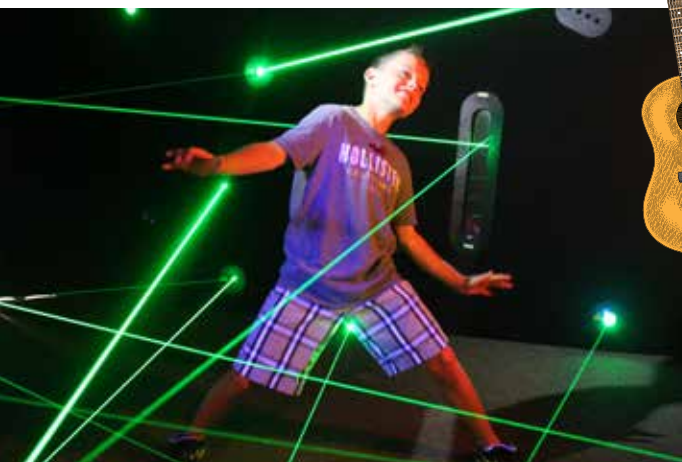

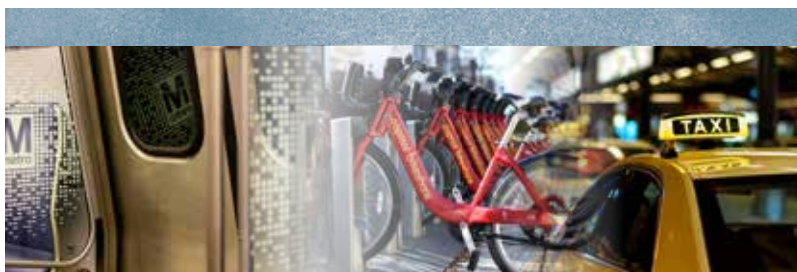

GETTING AROUND

BY METRO & BUS

There are 13 Red Line Metro stations that serve Montgomery County. These stations also offer transfers to Metro and Ride On buses.

Metro Buses and Montgomery County's Ride On buses serve most neighborhoods in the county.

BY BICYCLE

Capital Bikeshare system offers bicycles for rent at more than 300 stations in Maryland, Washington, DC, and Virginia.

Staying at the Canopy by Hilton at Pike & Rose? The hotel offers a bike loaner program for guests.



BY CAB, CAR SERVICE OR RIDE SHARE

Barwood Taxi has served Montgomery County since 1960, and features Verifone technology with credit card payment and video onboard.

BY CAR

From points northwest: I-70 East to I-270 South

From points northeast: I-95 South to I-495 towards Virginia and then I-270 North, or I-95 South to MD 200 West (MD 200 is an all-electronic toll road that only accepts the E-Z Pass for payment. If you do not have an E-Z Pass, you will receive a bill in the mail at a slightly higher rate.)

From points south: I-95 North to I-495 towards Baltimore and then I-270 North



BY TRAIN

Amtrak, the intercity rail, services BWI Airport and Union Station in Washington, DC. Take Ride On Bus 201 from BWI or MetroRail's Red Line from Union Station.

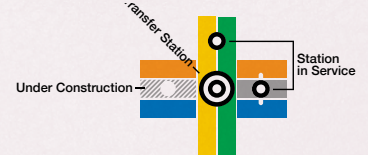

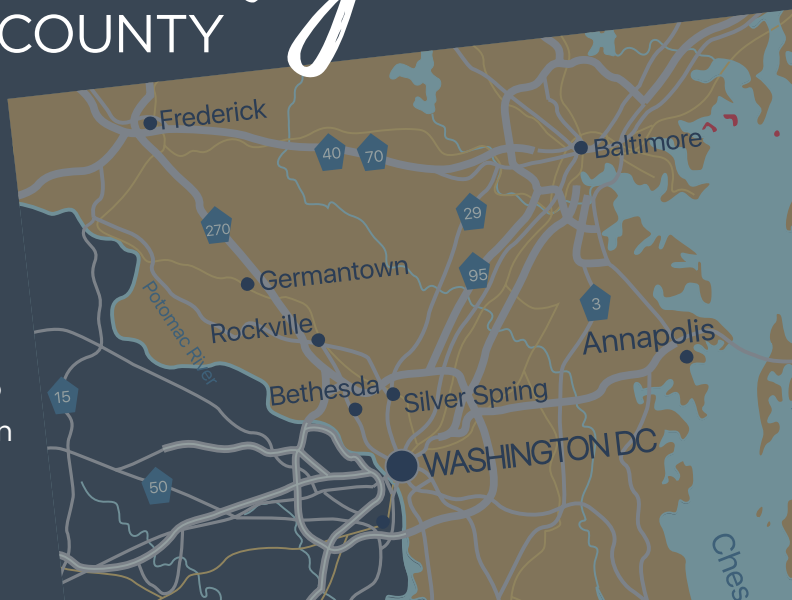

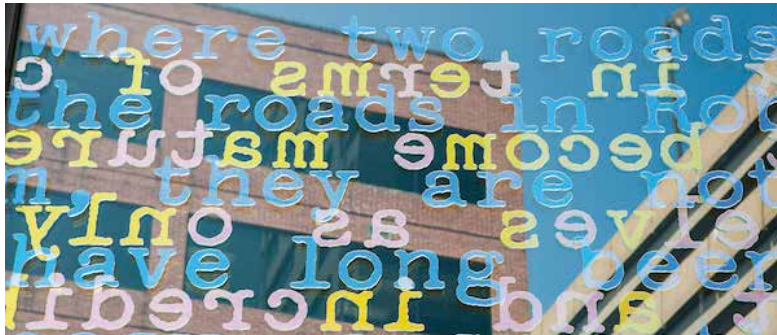

IT'S TIME TO RELAX & RECHARGE

Rockville Civic Center Park is centrally located and surrounded by some of Rockville's best places — Glenview Mansion, Croydon Creek Nature Center, F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre, formal gardens and a forest preserve.

The **Croydon Creek Nature Center** is a short distance from downtown Rockville. The center is nestled on 120 acres of forest preserve and presents a world of discovery through exhibits, informative programs and exploration. A Monarch butterfly garden and a winding creek bustling with wildlife is perfect for wandering.



A popular venue for special events, **Glenview Mansion** sits at the heart of the Civic Center overlooking 28 acres of beautifully landscaped grounds with ornamental gardens. Built in 1926, the elegant, Neo-Classical Revival home is on the National Register of Historic Places and considered a local historic landmark.



The **F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre** is a vibrant, local theatre dedicated to the performing arts. Located in the Civic Center, this 446-seat theatre boasts over 100 performances a year.

Experience a captivating musical by the Rockville Musical Theatre, feel moved by the Victorian Lyric Opera Company, or lose yourself in the spellbinding Rockville Civic Ballet. At the F. Scott Fitzgerald Theatre, there is truly something for everyone.

WHEATON/ KENSINGTON



Eat + Drink

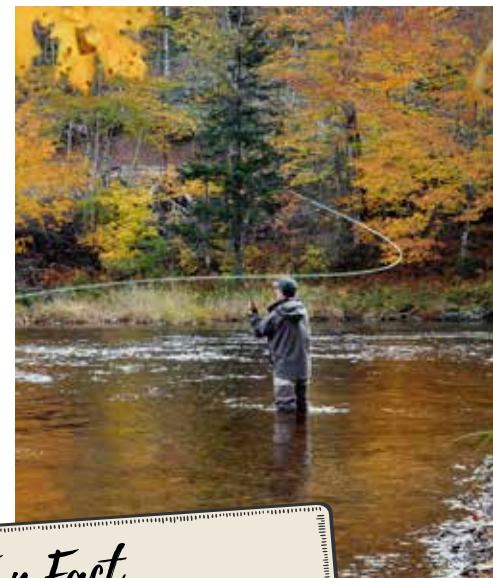
The Magruder-Bussard farmstead is within the Agricultural History Farm Park and is a preserved example of a Montgomery County farmstead at the turn of the 20th Century.

Eat + Drink

Taste the authentic flavors of grandma's kitchen at Cuba de Ayer with fan favorites like Ropa Vieja (shredded beef in a Cuban tomato sauce) and tres leches cake. Get a few friends together and head over to The Greene Turtle Sports Bar & Grille for brews and bar bites.

Shop + Find

Take a trip to Heyser Farms' year-round market for fresh fruit and vegetables, sweet cider, baked goods, flowers and mulch, local milk, eggs, bread, ice cream, honey, and jams.

In Burtonsville, Meadows Farms Nurseries & Landscape is the perfect place to pick up a new bird feeder or outdoor gift item.

See + Do

Take a ride through the woods in an electric streetcar and learn about the history, mission, and development of trolleys at The National Capital Trolley Museum in Colesville. Keep an eye out for heron, deer, and other wildlife during a hike through the Rocky Gorge Reservoir. The Patuxent River is an angler's dream come true. With a mix of wild brown trout, and stocked rainbow and browns, this river can be fished year-round. Established in 1959, Brighton Dam's Azalea Garden located at the Triadelphia Reservoir is home to over 22,000 azalea bushes over 5 acres in a hardwood forest. Kousa dogwood trees were added in the 1990's and the garden is also home to Montgomery County's champion fringe tree.

Architect Frank Lloyd Wright once had grand plans for an elaborate mountaintop observatory on top of Sugarloaf Mountain, but those plans never materialized.

Stay in a Historic Lockhouse

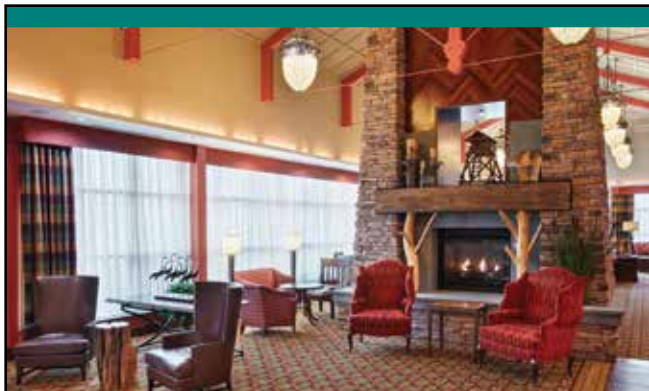
Originally home to a lockkeeper and his family during the Civil War, Lockhouse 25 can be rented for overnight stays.

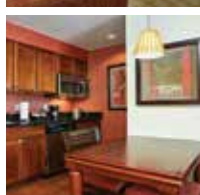

OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

Get out and enjoy hiking, biking, kayaking, and ropes courses in Montgomery County. Home to many parks and trails, it's perfect for a day outdoors. You can experience nature all around as you take in the beauty of the county.



Sugarloaf Mountain in Dickerson, MD is open to the public for hiking, rock climbing, and sightseeing. Sugarloaf offers three well-marked hiking trails: a 2.5-mile, 5-mile or a 7-mile loop. A popular trail is the Blue Northern Peak Trail loop. The Blue Trail Loop is a 5.5-mile loop trail that offers scenic views and is rated as difficult. The trail is primarily used for hiking, rock climbing, and walking and is accessible year-round.

Billy Goat Trail

A 4.7-mile hiking trail that follows the path between the C&O Canal and the Potomac River within the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal National Historical Park near Great Falls in Montgomery County. The entire Billy Goat Trail is made up of three separate sections, which start and finish on the C&O Canal.

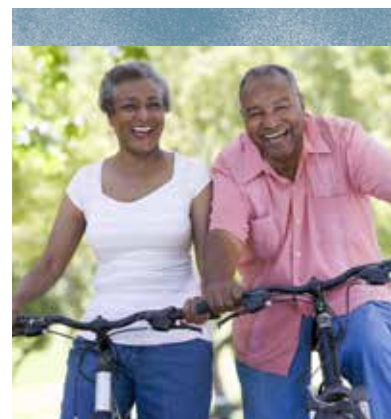
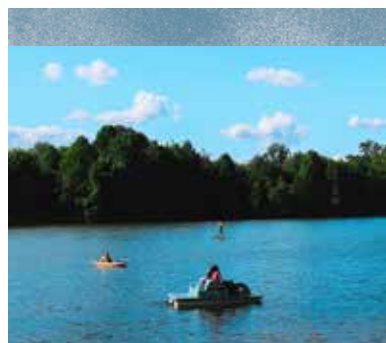
Brookside Gardens

For an afternoon of light hiking, explore the 50-acre award-winning public display garden at Brookside Gardens within Wheaton Regional Park. Featuring two conservatories, the park is open year-round with events such as the Wings of Fancy and Garden of Lights.

RENT A KAYAK

Experience Little Seneca Creek Park, the beautiful 505-acre lake as well as the wildlife that make the lake their home. The park, comprised of 6,300 acres, extends along 14 scenic miles of Seneca Creek, as it winds its way to the Potomac River. This area contains many scenic areas, including the 90-acre Clopper Lake, surrounded by forests and fields. Kayak rentals are available May through September.

Visitors to Rock Creek Regional Park can enjoy the beautiful 75-acre Lake Needwood in rental kayaks, rowboats, canoes, or pedal boats. Guests can also take a tour of the lake aboard the Needwood Queen during the summer season.



ENJOY A BIKE RIDE

The C&O Canal is a US National Historical Park home to 184.5 miles of towpath that runs parallel along the northern banks of the Potomac River with numerous trails ideal for biking and hiking. The park is also popular for running, biking, fishing, boating, and kayaking.

On the southern banks of the Potomac River is the Capital Crescent Trail. It is an 11-mile biker-hiker trail running from west Silver Spring to Georgetown, DC. The trail was formerly used as the Georgetown Branch rail line of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad.

ROPES COURSES

The Adventure Park in Sandy Spring consists of 13 different courses varying in degree of difficulty. Each trail has zip lines, but primarily consists of bridges between tree platforms made of rope, cable, and wood configurations, creating over 190 unique challenges.

Go Ape in Rock Creek Regional Park in Rockville is home to six zip lines, numerous rope ladders, 44 crossings to include the Stirrups and Twister, two Tarzan swings, and America's first skateboard zip line.

C&O CANAL NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

For nearly 100 years, The Chesapeake & Ohio Canal (C&O) was a main transportation route and lifeline for communities along the Potomac River. Today, it endures as an incredible natural attraction filled with historical and recreational treasures for all ages.



The C&O Canal National Historical Park
is the 8th most visited National Park in the U.S.

What to Know Before You Go

The C&O Canal Park is open all year during daylight hours and closes at dark. For those driving to the canal and looking to park on-site, there is an entrance fee at Great Falls Tavern Visitors Center. Parking in other areas along the park is free.

Chat with a Park Ranger at Great Falls Tavern Visitors Center

Formerly an Inn for people traveling along the canal, patrons enjoyed a tasty home-cooked meal, dancing in the ballroom of the northern wing, and the fine hospitality of Lockkeeper and Innkeeper Fenlon. The Visitors Center now serves as an excellent “home base” for exploring Great Falls and/or heading to the Billy Goat Trail.

Bike the Towpath

Stretching the entire 184.5 miles, the Canal towpath is a flat bike trail. The Capital Crescent Trail connects from the towpath into Bethesda.



Experience Great Falls on the Potomac River

The Great Falls are a must-see when visiting the park! There are three overlooks available to view the waterfalls and the Potomac River. Each are about a five- to ten-minute walk from the Visitor Center. There are many different activities to try, such as fishing, rock climbing, kayaking, and mule-drawn boat rides.



Hike the Billy Goat Trail

Experience the best hiking Montgomery County has to offer—the Billy Goat Trail. The trail not only offers scenic views of the river, but also has three hiking sections that are set for different skill levels.

Visit a Canal Town

Designated as an official “Canal Town” by the Canal Towns Partnership in 2020, Poolesville offers historic sites, great food and shopping with all the charms of a small community.

Explore Nearby National Historic Sites

Be sure to add the Clara Barton National Historic Site and the historic Glen Echo Park to your C&O Canal weekend getaway itinerary. Both sites are a short drive from Great Falls and offer easy parking.

Grab a Nosh

Three popular restaurants along the C&O Canal are Old Anglers Inn, The Irish Inn and Bassett's.

CANAL QUARTERS PROGRAM

The Canal Quarters Lockhouse program, managed by the C&O Canal Trust, provides guests the opportunity to step back in time and live like a lockkeeper for the night... or three! Each of the seven historic lockhouses – with five in Montgomery County, Maryland – are restored and furnished to each reflect a different time period in the canal’s history.



What to Expect

If you’re looking for a digital detox that will bring you and your loved ones closer to nature, then a night in a lockhouse is exactly what you need. Most lockhouses include fire rings for roasting marshmallows and telling tales of the canal. Or spend the evening reading historic nuggets displayed throughout the lockhouse.

Where to Stay in Montgomery County

Lockhouses 6, 10 and 21 “Swains” offer a full amenity experience including kitchens, bathrooms, electricity, heat and air-conditioning. For a rustic experience, lockhouses 22 and 25 are the perfect options. Think of them as camping with a historic twist.

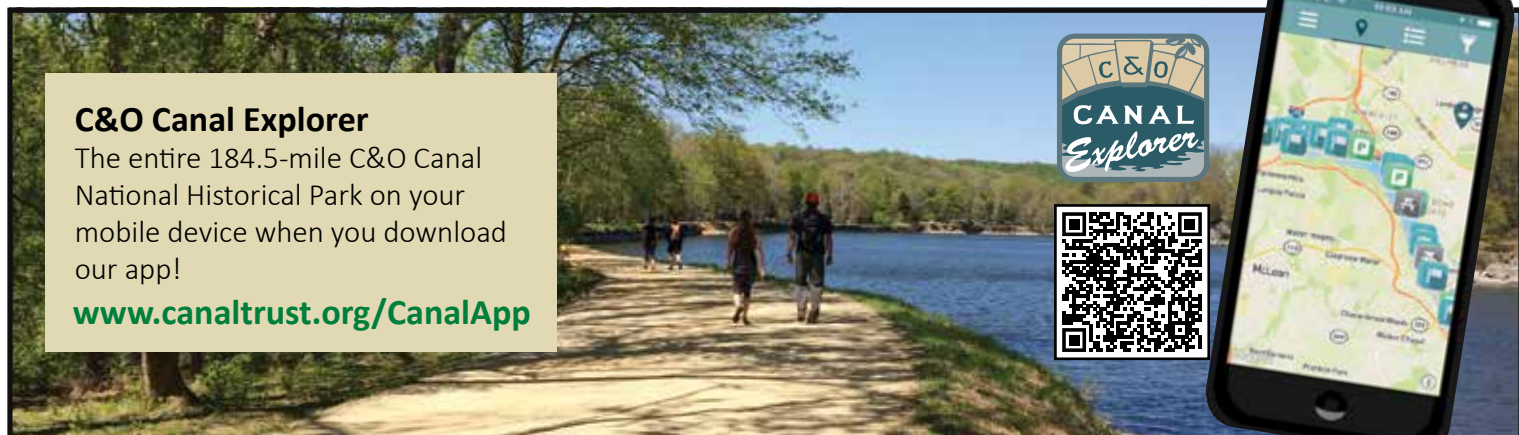
How To Book

HISTORY + HERITAGE

Founded in 1776, Montgomery County has done an incredible job in preserving and sharing the history of the community. History buffs will delight seeing the past come to life at these publicly accessible historical attractions in the area.

The Chesapeake & Ohio Canal National Historical Park

For nearly 100 years, The Chesapeake & Ohio Canal (C&O) was a lifeline for communities along the Potomac River. Today, it endures as a pathway for discovering historical and recreational treasures!

Take a trip back in time aboard the mule-drawn Charles F. Mercer packet boat at the Great Falls Tavern Visitor Center or stay overnight in a lockhouse through the award-winning Canal Quarters program managed by the C&O Canal Trust. Don't forget to visit The Monocacy Aqueduct. As the largest of the 11 aqueducts erected along the C&O Canal, it is often described by many historians as one of the finest canal features in the United States.

Woodlawn Manor Cultural Park

Experience Maryland as it looked in the early 1800s by visiting Woodlawn Manor Cultural Park in Sandy Spring. The Woodlawn Visitor Center is a stone barn full of interactive exhibits that tell the story of a bustling farm and the earliest residents of the Woodlawn community. Walk the Underground Railroad Experience Trail and imagine what it was like to be a freedom seeker.



Clara Barton National Historic Site

The Clara Barton National Historic Site in Glen Echo was established in 1974 to honor the life and work of Clara Barton, the founder of the American Red Cross. Notably, it is the first national historic site dedicated to the accomplishments of a woman.

This historic gem includes nine acres of land and Ms. Barton's own 38-room residence, which served as an early headquarters of the American Red Cross and where Barton spent the last 15 years of her life.

C&O Canal, Clara Barton House & Glen Echo Park



Gaithersburg Community Museum

Local history full steam ahead at the Gaithersburg Community Museum! Located in the B&O Rail complex in Olde Towne, the Museum's indoor/outdoor interpretive spaces provide hands-on learning centers for children that spark the imagination and exhibits that explore Gaithersburg's rich history.

Beall-Dawson House

The Beall-Dawson House was built in 1815 by Upton Beall, and then owned by the Dawson family and eventually the Davis family. Today, the house is the headquarters for the Montgomery County Historical Society. It still contains most of its original architecture, including the indoor slave quarters, and serves as a museum of life in 19th Century Rockville.



The National Museum of Health and Medicine

Home of the bullet that killed Abraham Lincoln, The National Museum of Health and Medicine in Silver Spring offers a treasure trove of collections dating back to the Civil War.

National Capital Trolley Museum

The National Capital Trolley Museum was established in 1959 to preserve and interpret the history of area electric streetcars. The renovated Visitor Center features exhibits and historic trolleys, and a model of streetcars and street life in Chevy Chase in the 1930s. Ride vintage streetcars on a 2-mile track through Northwest Branch Park.

White's Ferry

A unique cable ferry in operation since 1786. A popular crossing point for troops during the Civil War, it was known as Conrad's Ferry until being renamed after Confederate Col. Elijah Veirs White. While not currently in operation, the area is a relaxing place to visit, features views of the Potomac River and is a perfect spot for family picnics and hiking along the towpath.



Glen Echo Park

Glen Echo Park was developed in 1891 as a National Chautauqua Assembly, which taught the sciences, arts, languages, and literature. The Chautauqua lasted for just one season, and by the early 1900s, the site had become Glen Echo Amusement Park for the Washington, DC area. In 1971, the National Park Service acquired the park and collaborated with artists and arts organizations to create a rich arts program in the spirit of the original Chautauqua movement.

JOSIAH HENSON MUSEUM & PARK

Montgomery County's newest heritage experience, opened in spring 2021. The museum and grounds tells the story about the life and challenges of Reverend Josiah Henson, enslavement in Maryland, and the ongoing struggles of racial equality and justice. The Park is part of the National Park Service National Underground Railroad Network to Freedom program.



AN AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY ROAD TRIP

The history of African Americans in Montgomery County dates back to the late 1600s. But it was after the Civil War and emancipation in 1864 that the county saw more widespread establishment of free Black communities. Today, their legacy can be seen in the remains of houses and churches, schools, mills, fields, and waterways – places where people lived, worked, and prayed, fished, farmed, and raised families.

Tour Itinerary

Created by Heritage Montgomery, this self-guided road trip offers stories of home and community life as well as the experiences of African Americans during times of restriction and segregation. The sites are organized geographically rather than in the chronological order of their histories.

While there are many significant Black history sites in the county, this tour focuses on sites in the western part of the county that are open to the public or visible from the road. Hours may vary. Check the websites before you visit.

MONTGOMERY COUNTY'S *Rural Side*

► One third of the county is preserved for agricultural use.

► There are 540 farms and 350 horticultural enterprises.

► Montgomery County has the most acres planted in berries (blackberries, blueberries and strawberries) of any county in Maryland.



► Agriculture contributes over \$287 million to the county's economy.

Montgomery County, Maryland is home to a surprising number of rural areas. In 1980, the Montgomery County Council made one of the most significant land-use decisions in county history by creating an Agricultural Reserve, or what the locals call the "Ag Reserve." Heralded as one of the best examples of land conservation policies in the country, the Agricultural Reserve encompasses 93,000 acres, almost a third of the county's land resources.

Visit farms in the Agricultural Reserve in the spring for pick-your-own strawberries, blueberries, tart cherries, blackberries, red raspberries, and tomatoes. In the fall, families head out to the pumpkin patch, and during the holidays, they cut fresh trees. From the summit of Sugarloaf Mountain, hikers can look out over the county's pastoral patchwork of farms and villages, a countryside view largely unchanged since the 19th century.



► The county is home to the second-highest number of horses in Maryland (approximately 7,900).

Agricultural History Farm Park

The scenic 455-acre Agricultural History Farm Park in Derwood, MD features rolling hills, open fields, an apple orchard, and a variety of farm animals. Get a unique perspective on the county's rich farming heritage while visiting barns, historic buildings, a modern farming activity center, and other facilities at the park.



McKee-Beshers Wildlife Management Area

Top of visitors "must see" lists is the sunflower fields at McKee-Beshers Wildlife Management Area in Poolesville. Sunflowers are planted by hand each year to attract game birds. Deer, wild turkey and more than 200 species of birds have been known to wander the park, which is alongside the Potomac River. Peak blooms typically occur in July.

King Barn Dairy MOOseum

The King Barn Dairy MOOseum is a dairy heritage museum dedicated to interpreting the rich history of the farms, the families, and related organizations and businesses of Montgomery County. Their stories are told through a permanent collection featuring interactive exhibits and educational programs.





PERFORMANCE + ENTERTAINMENT

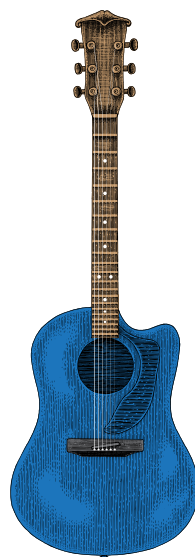

Boardwalk Stage

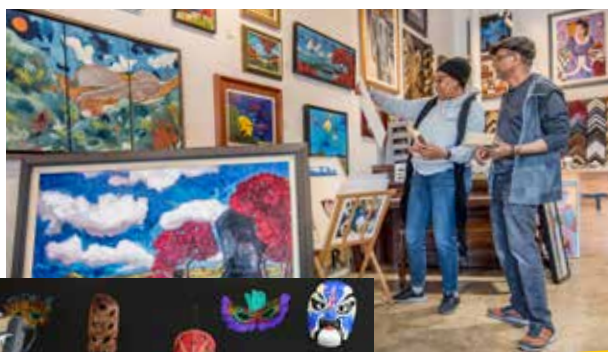

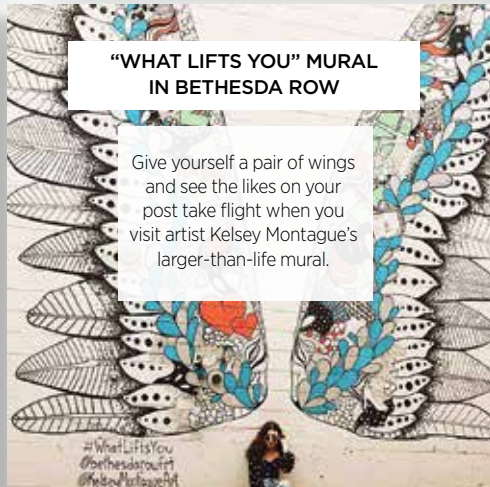

This easy-to-make cocktail features muddled strawberries, housemade ginger syrup, fresh squeezed lime juice and berry rum. Pair with one of Silver Diner's happy hour appetizers.

Rum Berry Mule

4-5 fresh strawberries, pitted
1 oz. fresh squeezed lime juice
2 oz. ginger beer syrup
1 ½ oz. berry rum
4 oz. plain seltzer water

Add the strawberries and lime juice to your copper mule cup, or rocks glass. Using a muddler or wooden spoon press the strawberries into the juice until the mixture takes on a pink hue. Pour in the ginger beer syrup and berry rum to the glass. Add seltzer water and allow the bubble to meld the ingredients together. Top with ice and garnish with a lime wedge and strawberry.
