

- Provide your Pride artwork to the Pride365 Shop to raise money for your organization.



Taste of Pride is an annual event series that celebrates the vibrant connection between the LGBTQ+ and culinary communities. This year's program will highlight a multi-month collaboration among Washington, D.C.'s Business Improvement Districts (BIDs), showcasing the unique flavors and culinary talents found within these dynamic neighborhoods.

The objectives of Taste of Pride are as follows:

- To raise funds for Capital Pride's PRIDE 365 Fund, which supports both Capital Pride initiatives and local LGBTQ+ organizations such as SMYAL and the DC LGBTQ Center.
- To launch a comprehensive awareness campaign aimed at engaging and informing the community about WorldPride 2025.
- To provide a roadmap for restaurants to prepare for, participate in, and enhance their involvement in WorldPride 2025.

Taste of Pride seeks to merge the culinary creativity of our city with the pride and diversity that characterize our community, paving the way for an unforgettable WorldPride celebration.



Facilitated by the Capital Pride Alliance, the Pride 365 Fund awards financial resources to 501(c)(3) organizations that demonstrate a commitment to the LGBTQ+ community 365 days a year.

- A portion of sponsorship and event partner revenue will be directed to the Pride 365 Fund.
- Funding Priorities:
 - The New LGBTQ+ Community Center
 - Sibling Prides (AAPI Pride, DC Black Pride, DC Latinx Pride, Trans Pride Washington, DC, Silver Pride, Youth Pride)
 - First-time Parade and Festival participating non-profit organizations.
 - Services and resources that promote collaboration among LGBTQ+ organizations.
 - Establishment of a LGBTQ+ Burial Fund




Safety
